

DriFlow Operator/Technician

Brief Description

The DriFlow Operator/Technician is responsible for working as a crew member assigned to the field. The candidate must demonstrate safe work habits, be able to follow directions and work well as part of a team. Major responsibilities include general maintenance and repair of equipment and attachments and assisting in field activities. This position will work under the direction of the DriFlow Supervisor or another supervisor as applicable.

Detailed Description

- Comply with all Company and customer Health, Safety, and Environmental (HS&E) policies, rules, practices and guidelines
- Ensure equipment is maintained at a high level of efficiency and readiness
- Conduct proper Job Safety Analysis (JSA) in compliance with Company regulations
- Perform rigging up and rigging down duties, as well as operate and maintain equipment
- Safely perform other duties that may include spotting trucks, checking product inventory levels and assisting with the clean-up of the location before, during, and after the job
- Employee must work with an emphasis on safety for themselves and others, including coworkers and third parties, while wearing any required personal protective equipment (PPE) at all designated times
- Perform other related duties as assigned
- Enhance and facilitate a positive organizational culture by accepting ownership for accomplishing new and different requests; explore opportunities to add value to company and job accomplishments

Physical requirements

Ability to stand for extended periods of time, stoop and bend, lift at least 50 pounds, maintain balance at elevated heights, climb ladders, and pass a pre-employment physical exam.

Minimum Qualifications

- High school diploma or GED equivalent
- Must have and maintain valid state-issued driver's license, be eligible to drive a Company vehicle and meet the requirements of the Company's vehicle program, policy and/or guidelines

Preferred Qualifications

- Five (5) years of stable related work history in oilfield completions, preferably on a hydraulic fracturing crew
- Prior experience in repair and maintenance of heave equipment
- Prior military service

Additional Details

This position requires the employee to work outdoors for long periods of time in all types of weather conditions typical of the area where the job is located, including dust, humidity, sleet, snow, rain, mud, cold, heat, wind, and other inclement weather. Working conditions for this position may involve exposure to varying outdoor conditions, including environmental chemicals, gases, noise, dampness, fumes, radiation and heights. Employee must be able to work closely with others in the confined area of the job, in a fast-paced team environment.
